

ECSA SUSTAINABILITY CHARTER

ECSA pledges to:

- establish a **comprehensive sustainability strategy** that guides its **environmental actions and decisions**, which will be implemented in all its projects.
- actively work towards reducing its ecological footprint across all activities. This includes:
 - promoting the **use of sustainable transportation** to minimise travel-related emissions, and implementing **energy-efficient practices** in our offices and events.
 - implementing **green office practices**, including energy conservation, recycling, waste reduction, and the use of sustainable materials and supplies.
 - ensuring that **all events organised are conducted as sustainably as possible**, including selecting eco-friendly venues, minimising waste, using digital resources over printed materials (e.g. digital brochure instead of single-use disposable documents such as program leaflets) and providing sustainable catering options (e.g. local and seasonal ingredients, plant-based or vegetarian menus).
- continue **fostering knowledge exchange and reflection** around key issues related to sustainability within its Assemblies and Committee meetings, ensuring continuous learning and improvement in its sustainability practices.
- report its **progress towards sustainability goals**, using data to inform its actions and demonstrate its commitment to environmental responsibility (e.g. percentage of time and budget allocated to sustainability-related projects).
